TITLE: FORMULATION OF POLICY

The board of trustees shall reserve to itself the function of providing guides for the discretionary action of those to whom it delegates authority. These guides for discretionary action shall constitute the policies governing the operation of the school system.

The formulation and adoption of these written policies constitutes the basic method by which the board of trustees exercises its leadership in the operation of the school system.

The study and evaluation of reports concerning the execution of its written policies should constitute the basic method by which the board of trustees exercises control over the operation of the school system.
