TITLE: APPOINTMENT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT

The Board of Trustees of school districts other than elementary school districts shall employ a Superintendent of schools for a term not to exceed three years. This should normally be accomplished at the regular meeting of the board in January. His/her term shall begin on the first day of July unless circumstances warrant otherwise.

The person selected by the board to serve as Superintendent of schools must be qualified for and hold an Idaho Administrators Certificate endorsed for the Superintendency. The employment of the Superintendent is by contract on a form approved by the State Board of Education.

Compensation

The salary paid the Superintendent shall be determined at contract time at the discretion of the Board.
