TITLE: CERTIFICATION

Every person who is employed to serve in any elementary or secondary school in the capacity of teacher, supervisor, administrator, education specialist, school nurse or school librarian shall be required to have and to hold a certificate issued under authority of the State Board of Education, valid for the service being rendered; except that the State Board of Education may authorize endorsement for use in Idaho, for not more than five years, certificates valid in other states when the qualifications therefore are not lower than those required for an Idaho certificate. (Idaho Code, Section 33-1201)

The State Board of Education has ruled that all teachers must qualify for a proper certificate at the time of entering upon a teaching assignment. Certification is not to be provided for any school year to an applicant who did not qualify for a certificate at the time of starting the teaching assignment.
