**TITLE: STUDENT TEACHERS**

Future generations of America's children will be guided in their school experiences by college students currently preparing to teach. The quality of the educational opportunity available to these children will depend to a large degree upon the kind of teachers our colleges prepare now. While many factors contribute to the development of skillful and artistic teachers, few are more important than the first-hand contacts the student teacher has with the children in the school situation.

Every superintendent in the State of Idaho should cooperate with colleges of education to provide the best possible on-the-job training for young people who wish to enter the profession.

The program of practice teaching in the Wilder District shall be under the supervision of the Superintendent of Schools or his delegated representative.

The instructor for the college in charge of teacher training shall have the privilege of visiting at any time the student teacher who is working in the Wilder District.

The details of the student teaching program are to be worked out by the Superintendent and the individual in charge of teacher training in the institution of higher learning.
