**TITLE: SENIOR FIELD DAY**

Participation in a district sponsored Senior Field Day is considered a privilege, not a right. In order to participate in Senior Field day activities the following conditions will be met:

1. Students must be on track to graduate, one week prior to the day of the trip.
2. Students who have been involved in Disciplinary Actions during the year may be excluded at the discretion of the principal. Timely appeals may be made to the Superintendent.
3. Violation of school rules during the trip may result in the following consequences:
  - a. the student will be sent home at his/her own expense.
  - b. other disciplinary actions may be taken in accordance with current district discipline policy.
4. A minimum of four adult chaperons, two of which must be school employees, shall accompany the seniors on their trip. Volunteers must be fingerprinted six weeks in advance of the trip.
5. The School District will contribute a maximum of \$250.00 for transportation on the trip
6. All arrangements, including funding, must be completed and submitted to the Principal and school board by March 1.
8. Senior Field Day activities will be limited to one day away from school. Overnight trips will not be allowed.
