TITLE: EXCHANGE STUDENT HONORARY DIPLOMAS

In an effort to promote global awareness and cultural exchange, Wilder High School has traditionally hosted foreign exchange students.

Often, these exchange students have achieved senior status or have already graduated from their home country's high school.

In recognition of their senior status and of having completed a full year with Wilder high school students, it is the desire of the Wilder Board of Trustees to grant honorary Wilder High School Diplomas to exchange students who meet the following criteria:

- Enrolled in the senior class as a full-time student
- Possesses a 3.0 grade point average
- Be in compliance with district attendance policies
- Enrolled in English, American History, and/or American Government
- Be at least 17 years of age at the conclusion of the senior school year.

Honorary diplomas will not qualify any student for entrance into any post-secondary education program.
