TITLE: INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

The overall organization of the instructional program shall be designed to facilitate the philosophy of the Wilder Board of Education's Strategic Plan, which is to serve the educational needs of all pupils in our charge. The education program shall be diversified, compatible with the needs of the community and state and federal standards

The basic structure of the instructional system shall consist of two main programs: the elementary program and the secondary program.

The elementary program shall include kindergarten through grade five. The secondary program shall consist of the middle school for grades six through eight and the senior high school for grades nine through twelve.

This organization has also been designed to meet the accreditation standards chosen by the Wilder Board of Education.

The administrative personnel are responsible for apprising the Board of the educational program's current and future status. The Superintendent should prepare periodic reports that include:

- A review and evaluation of the present curriculum;
- A projection of curriculum and resource needs;
- A plan for new or revised instructional program implementations; and
- A review of present and future facility needs.
