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TITLE: SPECIAL EDUCATION

The Wilder School District recognizes the unique needs of students with disabling conditions and their potential for significant educational development when receiving special services designed to meet their education needs.

It is the policy to make reasonable effort to provide an appropriate special education program which best meets the needs of all students with disabilities attending school within the District. The District shall comply with the State Board of Education Rules and Regulations for Public Schools K-12, Idaho Code, applicable Federal Regulations outlined in the Individuals with Disabilities Education improvement Act (IDEA 2004) and applicable regulations outlined in Section 504, U.S. Rehabilitation Act of 1973 regarding the provision of such services for students with disabilities.

This policy will embrace all students with disabilities as defined by law. Whenever a student's behavior violates the standards adopted by the school district, action will be taken which may deny the privileges and rights of school attendance.

The procedures for implementing this policy are outlined in the "Idaho Special Education Manual." Please refer to this publication for procedures relating to all phases of the Special Education Program.
