This letter is to inform you that we have had confirmed cases of influenza in our school. Influenza is a very contagious respiratory tract disease caused by a virus. The common time for this virus is from December to May.

The more common symptoms are:

Fever, headache, chills, body aches, cough, and sore throat. If you notice these symptoms please contact your doctor as soon as possible and do not send your child to school. This illness is severe and can cause health complications in the elderly, young children and people with low immune systems. Please keep your student home and away from others who's health could severe be compromised if they got the flu.
